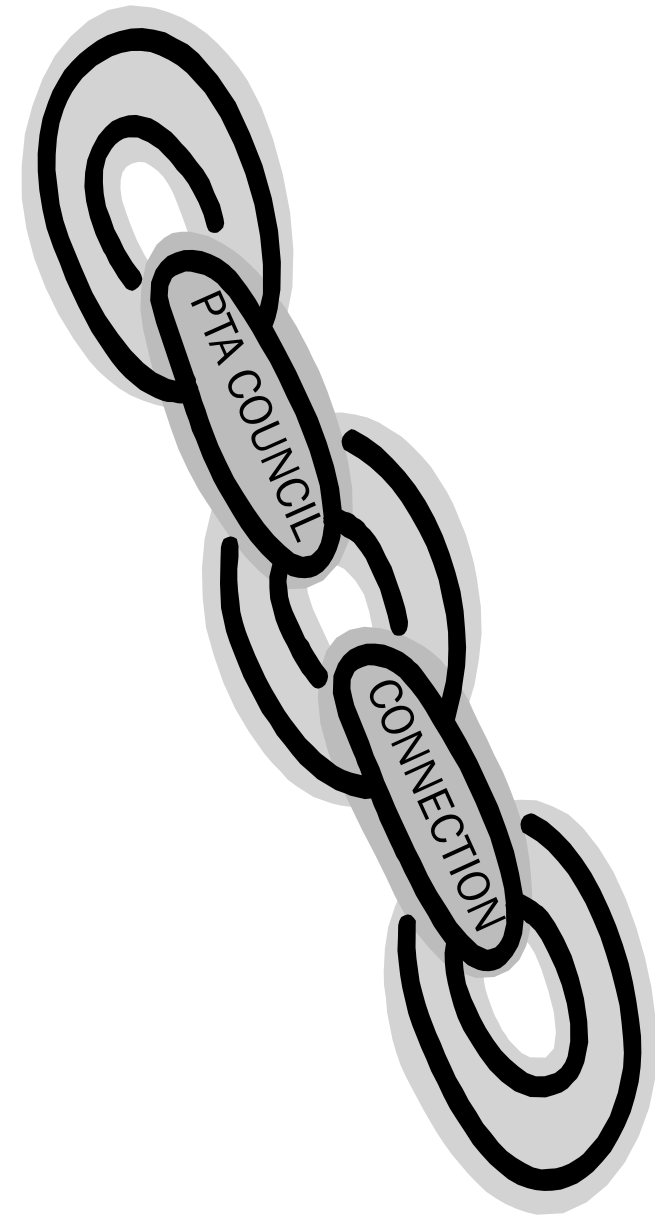

PTA COUNCILS MAY:

Coordinate the efforts of council member local units.

Spearhead community projects.

Sponsor PTA Study Courses and Workshops.

Alert the Illinois PTA when parents or school groups show an interest in PTA.

Create an awareness of the need for action through united strength.

Sponsor community-wide public meetings on any and all education, school, child and youth concerns, including candidate forums.

NOT:

Duplicate or encroach upon the work of any local unit.

Legislate the activities of a any local unit.

A PTA COUNCIL IS:

- **A link to the District, State and National PTA**
- **A minimum of 3 Local PTA Units in any geographic area**
- **Represented on the PTA District Board**
- **An opportunity to network with, support and inspire fellow PTA leaders**
- **Organized under the authority of the Illinois PTA State Board of Managers**
- **A coordinating body which promotes communication and cooperation among member units**
- **Expected to work with school boards and administrators towards a common goal**
- **Available to assist PTA leaders**
- **Not required to pay dues to the State and National PTA**

PTA OBJECTS/PURPOSES
To promote the welfare of children and youth in home, school, community and place of worship.
To raise the standards of home life.
To secure adequate laws for the care and protection of children and youth.
To bring into closer relation the home and the school that parents and teachers may cooperate intelligently in the education of children and youth.
To develop between educators and the general public such united efforts as will secure for all children and youth the highest advantages in physical, mental social and spiritual education
