The PTA Money Matters 201 Course is designed to provide advanced financial information to help PTA leaders. PTA Money Matters 101 is a prerequisite to taking the Money Matters 201 Course.

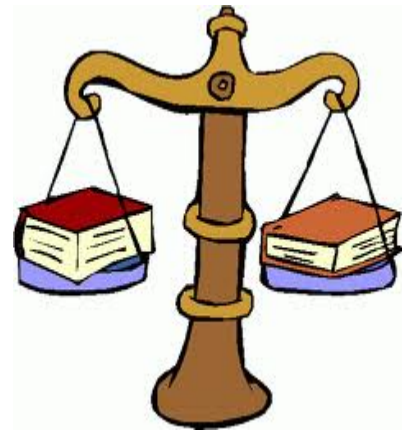
The 2-hour class is intended to be interactive, with group exercises and discussion questions included. Each participant will receive a course booklet. In addition, if a PowerPoint presentation is given, participants will receive a printed copy of the slideshow.

Attendance at the PTA Money Matters 201 Course is one of the requirements for the Illinois PTA University Master's Degree, a recognition/ incentive program developed to encourage PTA leaders to take advantage of a variety of training opportunities.

Course Subject Matter

This course will take you more in depth into some of the legal issues you may encounter as a 501 (c) (3) association, including an IRS audit, PTA as a contractor or employer, regulations surrounding games of chance (gaming fundraisers), corporate sponsorships, vendors, U.S. Postal regulations, copyrights, lobbying, school tax referenda, and more.

It is suggested that all PTA treasurers take this course, but it contains many legal issues that other PTA officers may want to be aware of.
